How it works



Registration for COVID-19 Vaccination Portal through myHealth folio

Make a registration on myHealth folio to sign up yourself and your loved ones for a COVID-19 vaccine.

To register for vaccination visit my.health.mv

Registration

When signing up, you would need to provide the following details.

1. Name
2. Sex
3. Date of Birth
4. Nationality
5. National ID number (mandatory if Local)
6. Passport number (mandatory if Foreigner)
7. A local mobile phone number
8. An email address
9. A password

Once you press the sign up button, you will receive a text message with a one-time-password (OTP) to the phone number given to us during registration. The SMS will be in the following format.

“Use V-XXXXXX code to verify and complete your profile at <https://my.health.mv/verify>
#StaySafe”

How it works



For Maldivians, ID card number will be compulsory and adding your passport number will be useful for people planning to travel.

For foreigners with work permits, provide us with your work permit number so that we can verify you at the earliest.

You can edit your profile your biodata until our verification process is completed. Once verified, your national identity number (if local), your passport number (if foreigner) as well as your date of birth will be locked.

Since we want to have the most up-to-date information of you, you should keep your profile updated at all times. Pay special attention to updating your contact details and current address as we want to know how we can reach you.

You can login to your account using either your phone number, email address, national identity number or your passport number with your password.

The number you have given us during registration cannot be used to make another separate primary registration. However, the same number can be given to your dependants if you have any.

Dependants can only be people under your guardianship (parents, children, aunt etc) or live with you.

Registering your dependants

Individuals with a unique identity (National Identity, Passport Number) can be added to the myHealth self-care folio only once.

The details required for making an account is required when adding dependent, with the addition of providing us with your relationship to the dependant. However, a password and OTP is not required when adding dependants.

Adding a dependant's direct phone number is advised, as we may need to contact them directly.

Updating profile

You can update your profile by using the small pencil button near your profile picture. In the case of your dependants, open the dependants tab and press the update button to update their information for them. It will take you through 5 steps where you can update your information.

1. Personal
2. Permanent Address
3. Current Address
4. Occupation
5. Health Condition

You can revisit each step whenever you need and update to us with the most up-to-date information of you.

It is very important to let us know of changes to your contact information and current address so that we can allocate vaccines to you if you are eligible.

If you are employed, let us know the work location type and place of work at a minimum.

A list of set health conditions, which are categorized as high risk to the effects of COVID-19, will be available to you to pick whenever applicable. Let us know the health conditions of yourself and your loved ones so that we make a prior assessment before allocating vaccines to you.

In addition, if any of your dependant has a physical disability restricting mobility, let us know so that we can make the necessary arrangements for home visitation.

Registration for the platform or adding as dependants does not guarantee eligibility for vaccination.
